- 2) It is designed to prevent the overboard discharge of treated or untreated sewage or any waste derived from sewage.

Under the provisions of 33 CFR 159.12(a), Type III MSDs are not issued a USCG certification number and may not be labeled under 33 CFR 159.16

You must notify the MSC in writing when you make any change in the design or construction of these devices. A Type III certification does not expire as long as no modifications have been made.
